Discussion about garage doors. When the door is unhooked from the trolley (the electric opener is disengaged) you should be able to pull the door up half way and it will stay there. When opened all the way it should also stay up. If not, the door springs needs adjusting. Call a service to do that. Another safety test is to put a 1" board on the floor where the door would close. With the opener engaged use the remote control to close the door. The door should stop and reverse when it hits the board. If not the opener needs adjusting.

Many had something to say about storm shutters. What type and what company to use. We will be getting a list of suggested companies for men's coffee notes later.

One mentioned if we want Kathryn to show up that we change our meeting time or meeting day of the week or both to fit her schedule. The idea was informally tabled.

Talk on the quality of ground / tree maintenance: trees leaning, sidewalks heaving from tree roots, etc. Conclusion was to tell Kathryn what are your observations and problems.

Another question concerned the need for an emergency exit as a backup to the main gate. One person was very concerned with the lack of one.
